Lepcha durry is a traditional attire of the Sikkim. Generally, it is thick cotton fabrics woven on loom. 2/20s cotton yarn used for weaving. They use geometrical pattern to ornament the cloth. Basically, it is used as outer garment to combat winter and also, symbol of tradition of this area.
