ELIGIBILITY FOR APPLICANTS

Applicants must fulfil the educational qualification, experience and age limit and other criteria for the post applied for, as on the last date of receipt of the applications, failing which the application shall be summarily rejected and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard. Candidates are, therefore, advised to satisfy themselves before applying for the post(s) that they possess the requisite essential qualification and experience. The prescribed essential qualifications are the bare minimum and mere possession of the same does not entitle candidates to be called for the Written Test/Practical Test/Selection. The candidates who are willing to apply for more than one post are required to submit a separate application against each post in the prescribed format.
